This past week, 927 voting members representing the 65 synods, 9100 congregations, and 3.5 million members of the ELCA met in Milwaukee for the triennial Churchwide Assembly.

This is the business meeting of the national church. This year the agenda included the 2020-22 budget, a celebration of the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Ordination of Women into the Ministry of Word & Sacrament, final decisions on the ELCA's newest social statement, "Faith, Sexism, and Justice – A Lutheran Call to Action," and the election of our presiding bishop.

At press time, Bishop Elizabeth Eaton had been reelected to her position on the first ballot by a strong majority for another 3-year term.

Voters approved a motion to declare the ELCA a Sanctuary Body – meaning that it supports the humane treatment of migrants and refugees. Participants marched to the ICE building in Milwaukee where they held a prayer vigil for migrant children and their families alongside ELCA staff members, AMMPARO leaders, and other leaders in this area of concern.
