Updates from the Servant Team

The Bethel Servant Team met this week and spent much of the meeting discussing the current health of the congregation during this pandemic and ways of continuing to build on the successes we've had over the past few months. **Here are the highlights:**

- 1. The Call Committee continues to work with their preferred candidate and hopes to arrange a visit this Fall. The Servant Team & Call Committee will be meeting with Pr. Katy after worship today for some additional counseling from the Synod, including considering new options for worship leadership while we await our candidate's visit.
- 2. After several false starts, Bethel now has a Safe Church Policy. This gives us a clear set of policies and procedures to conduct background checks on key volunteers and employees in order to create a safe environment for our children and vulnerable adults. It also establishes guidelines to maintain good boundaries for the people trusted to care for our monetary gifts.
- **3.** The Servant Team continues to assess the infection rate in Placer County as a guideline for resuming any **in-person worship**. As mentioned in June, our goal is still to do a thorough **analysis after Labor Day.** Returning to worship at Bethel's campus even outdoors on the lawn will take a **considerable amount of volunteer effort** to set up and take down each week so part of the discernment will be the availability of consistent volunteers. We also seek to balance the number of people willing to worship in person with that effort. We recognize that as much as we may want to return to normal, that's a long way off, and that with few exceptions we are **worshiping online with an attendance at or above our pre-pandemic levels.** Please be patient as we attempt to make the best decision for the congregation. **If you have questions or comments don't hesitate to contact a Servant Team member.**
- 4. Finally, although we may not be able to safely meet in person for fellowship activities, there are other ways we can hang out virtually. We are gathering ideas for creative, socially distanced fun and would love to hear your ideas!
