CELEBRATING A BAPTISMAL ANNIVERSARY

This order may be given to a family on the baptismal day with instructions to keep it with the baptismal candle. For other suggestions on celebrating a baptismal anniversary, see "10 Ways to Celebrate Your Child's Baptismal Anniversary" and "Ways to Celebrate Your Godchild's Anniversary" in Washed and Welcome: A Baptism Sourcebook, and Living the Promises of Baptism: 101 Ideas for Parents (both Augsburg Fortress, 2010), both part of the Washed and Welcome family of baptismal resources.

Gather around a table where you usually share a meal, or at some other quiet place in your home, with a bowl of water and the baptismal candle. As the candle is lighted, the leader begins.

In the name of the Father, and of the **†** Son, and of the Holy Spirit. **Amen.**

We remember and give thanks for the baptism of name. Thanks be to Jesus for the saving waters of baptism.

A hymn may be sung. One of these from Evangelical Lutheran Worship or another favorite may be used:

- 451 We are Baptized in Christ Jesus
- 456 Baptized in Water
- 459 Wade in the Water
- 613 Thy Holy Wings
- 781 Children of the Heavenly Father
- 815 I Want to Walk as a Child of the Light

The group joins together in reading and discussing one of the following: The Lord's Prayer (ages 1-5) The Apostles' Creed (ages 4-8) The Ten Commandments (ages 7-12) These foundational baptismal texts and their explanations can be found in Evangelical Lutheran Worship, along with Luther's explanations, on pages 1160 and following. They encompass the three pillars of faith that parents and sponsors committed to teach their child at the time of his or her baptism.

Rejoice in sharing memories and stories of the baptismal day.

The leader continues. Let us bless the Lord. **Thanks be to God.**

Almighty God bless us and keep us, by the Holy Spirit guiding our days, our thoughts, and our actions, in the grace of Jesus Christ. **Amen.**

All join in dipping their hands in the water and making the sign of the cross on their own or one another's forehead.
