

Here is a little more information about the song: Sylvia Dunstan was a hymnwriter and a United Church of Canada pastor who died tragically of liver cancer at age thirty-eight. Alan Barthel, her mentor and collaborator. with less than a week's notice commissioned a text built on the Great Commission (Matt. 28:19-20) for the 1985 Emmanuel College (Toronto) Convocation. Written to Ralph Vaughan Williams's expansive sine nomine (usually paired with "For all the saints"), it gives this beloved tune an alternate text pairing.
