#### New Interim Bishop for the Sierra Pacific Synod!

This week we welcomed, Rev. Claire S. Burkat, as the interim bishop for our synod. She was appointed by our synod council following consultation with ELCA Presiding Bishop Eaton. Burkat joins the Sierra Pacific Synod from the Southeastern Pennsylvania (SEPA) Synod, where she served two terms as bishop (2006-2018). She is a 1978 graduate of the Lutheran Theological Seminary at Philadelphia and has served as a congregational pastor, assistant to the bishop, and mission director with the SEPA Synod, New Jersey Synod, and the Episcopal Diocese of Pennsylvania. She hopes to begin her work in our synod on July 10<sup>th</sup>. Pastor Carolyn was able to meet her this week and you're welcome to ask her questions after worship about impressions of Rev. Burkat.
