Last Sunday we had both our semi-annual congregation meeting and our annual Leadership Team retreat. (Attending the retreat were the members of the Servant Team, Susan Woods, and Kary Pfennig) In case you missed the summary email that was sent out this past week, here're the highlights.

• Lisa Herlocker and Rick Mendonsa were re-elected to the Servant Team for new two-year terms as Vice-President and Treasurer respectively

• The Call Committee has found a candidate to recommend. The next step involves a visit to Roseville to meet the people of Bethel and tour the area. They have begun working out the details of how that might happen safely. Details of how you might participate will be shared soon.

• A theme has been chosen for our upcoming 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary celebrations – "Creating Bridges" – focusing on not only bridges between past, present, and future, but also finding ways to create bridges among the diverse people of our community. As we look ahead to 2021, if you have ideas or are interested in helping to plan any celebrations, work service projects, or community outreach activities, please contact a member of the Servant Team.

• A safe return to in-person worship is still weeks away and patience is encouraged. The Servant Team will discuss details and writing a specific plan at their July meeting. Decisions will be based the state's guidelines, the synod's recommendations, and the county's health numbers. The general idea will be holding outdoor worship gatherings when it is safe to do so. In the meantime, Bethel will purchase items to meet hygiene and shade needs. The Servant Team is also working to establish the means to stream worship once Bethel returns to in person services for those who wish to remain at home.

• The Servant Team would love to see other opportunities for fellowship in addition to Sunday's worship and Wednesday's Fellowship Time. If you have any interest hosting a virtual fellowship activity, please contact any member of the Servant Team to help you set it up.

• Finally, as the weeks of pandemic life continue, please do all you can to keep yourselves healthy both mentally and physically.
