Your presence is important to us – we are not complete without you. We mean it when we say “all are welcome” – no matter where you are on your faith journey or how you identify.

Families with young children are encouraged to sit near the front of the sanctuary so children can see what is happening. Parents and other near-by adults can help developing readers follow along with the congregation and the printed Order of Worship. Be patient with our children as they learn to participate in the rituals of worship. Celebrate as they learn to help with various aspects of worship leadership. Small gestures can go a long way.

Some Practical Visitor Info

If you need a restroom, you have two options. In the sanctuary building, you will find the restroom through the side door near the piano. You can also access it by going outside through the main entrance and re-entering the building near the offices by using the door located under the bell tower. The restroom will be to your left.

If you need an accessible restroom or a baby changing table, you can find that in our back building. Go through the iron gate at the rear of our patio on the left of the sanctuary. As you enter that back building the restroom is immediately to your left.

Prayer Requests

Paper is available as you enter for you to write prayer requests on. Return the paper to an usher no later than during the Hymn of the Day. The reader will include it during the Prayers of the People. It is our hope that this will help all those in worship hear the prayers.

Grants Received!!!

This Spring Bethel applied for two grants from the Lutheran Development Society of Sacramento and we've been granted both requests.

A \$4000 grant will be used to fund a regional all-ages concert on August 18th featuring Tyra Dennis and Joe Davis, Lutheran musicians and spoken word artists who perform together as *Lyrical Avenue*. The event will be free to attend with an offering collected for the *Connections* program of Lutheran Social Services of Northern California which provides housing services, case management, and life skills training to formerly unhoused young adults in the Sacramento area. More details will be coming soon, but for now put the date on your calendars – you won't want to miss the fun!

A second grant of \$670 will be used to help fund the meals we serve several times a year at St. Vincent de Paul's “soup kitchen” and other programs for the hungry in the local Roseville area.
