From the Servant Team

We've spent a significant amount of time (in coordination with the Worship & Music Team) researching County, State and Synod Guidelines, thinking about the effect on ourselves and the community, and discussing how to best serve the congregation as we work on the timing of reopening the sanctuary to inperson worship.

At this time the Servant Team feels that practicing patience with this decision will give us the time to see how reopening effects Placer County in general and church communities specifically. We feel in the coming weeks will have more clarity on the best practices needed to protect what we most treasure – our community. While we are being patient with resuming in-person worship, we are exploring how streaming options, smaller group gatherings, and outdoor services can be done safely while expanding the communal worship experience Bethel offers.

A large part of the retreat for the upcoming Leadership Team Retreat will be the crafting of a return to in-person worship plan. Feel free to share your thoughts, suggestions, and concerns with any member of the Servant Team in the coming weeks.
