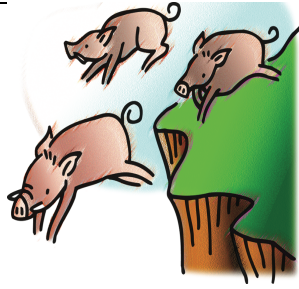


Welcome to Bethel! We're glad you're here!

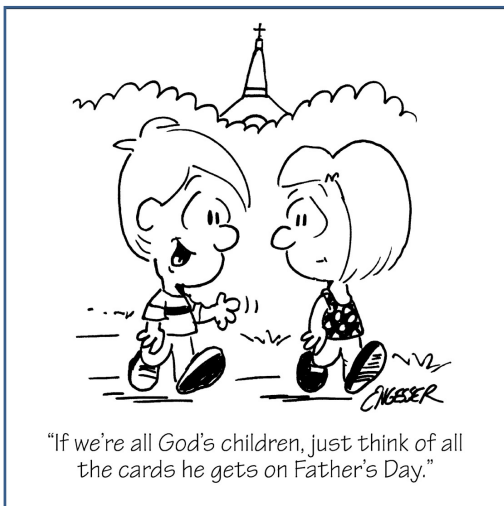
