Worship Notes for Trinity Sunday

Today we'll recite the Athanasian Creed, one of 3 creeds written in the early years of the Christian Church. All three creeds (Apostles, Nicene & Athanasian) affirm that God is fully present in Jesus, that Jesus Christ is both God and human (not a semi-divine or superhuman creature that is neither). These three creeds are called ecumenical because they are all accepted and used by the overwhelming majority of the world's Christians. All three are affirmed in the Lutheran confessional writings and in the ELCA's governing documents.



The agenda will include voting for two Servant Team positions: president and secretary; budget updates; and some facility construction news. We will have a printed annual report to share.

Grants Received!!!

This Spring Bethel applied for two grants from the Lutheran Development Society of Sacramento and we've been granted both requests.

A \$4000 grant will be used to fund a regional allages concert on August 18th featuring Tyra Dennis and Joe Davis, Lutheran musicians and spoken word artists who preform together as *Lyrical Avenue*. The event will be free to attend with an offering collected for the *Connections* program of Lutheran Social Services of Northern California which provides housing services, case management, and life skills training to formerly unhoused young adults in the Sacramento area. More details will be coming soon, but for now put the date on your calendars – you won't want to miss the fun!

A second grant of \$670 will be used to help fund the meals we serve several times a year at St. Vincent de Paul's "soup kitchen" and other programs for the hungry in the local Roseville area.
