The reader will read all of the prayer requests for the day from the lectern microphone. Hopefully, this will help all of us in worship hear the prayers and engage more deeply in the life of the congregation.

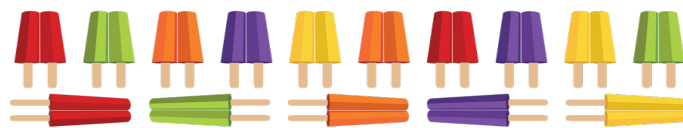
