## *It's Trinity Sunday!*

Today we ponder the doctrine of the Trinity – a vision of God that is deeply relational – three ongoing relationships that meet us where we are – in and among our relationships with the people around us. The Book of Genesis tells us that we are each created in the image of God – each of us in a relationship with God and one another. This is profound in a culture too often torn apart by individualism, isolation, and division. The doctrine of the Trinity reminds us that relationships are who we are. If our relationships are healthy, then we are healthy. If relationships are unhealthy, we have to work towards reconciliation, healing, and restoration.

In that light, you are invited to consider joining with some of your Bethel friends for a time of conversation and exploration as we look at the legacy of racism in our nation and learn how we can “do the work” of becoming anti-racists.
