. . . and questions continue to abound. Who would have thought that this would be our 12<sup>th</sup> Sunday of online worship when we began this adventure back in March?

As a Servant Team, we've spent a significant amount of time researching County, State and Synod Guidelines, thinking about the effect on ourselves and the community, and discussing how to best serve the congregation as we work on the timing of reopening the sanctuary to in-person worship. At this time the Servant Team feels that practicing patience with this decision will give us the time to see how reopening effects Placer County in general and church communities specifically. We feel in the coming weeks will have more clarity on the best practices needed to protect what we most treasure – our community. While we are being patient with resuming inperson worship, we are exploring how streaming options, smaller group gatherings, and outdoor services can be done safely while expanding the communal worship experience Bethel offers.

In the midst of this uncertainty, we are also continuing our call process. The Call Committee is working closely with candidates and look forward to a time to meet them in person in Roseville. As that time approaches, we'll have more specifics to share.
