Just pick a category to start with and label the center of the wheel as "zero" and the outside rim as "ten." Mark your present state of wellness in that area with a number. Do that for all the categories. Then starting with the area with the lowest number, create reasonable, measurable goals to help you improve your number - and wellness. Choose reasonable goals that you can complete in a specific amount of time. Share your goals with a trusted friend - for encouragement and eventual celebration. Follow your plan until you have completed the circle. As you do, you'll feel good about yourself and become more of whom God wants you to be in this world. Undoing old habits and creating new ones takes time and hard work. Give yourself grace as you move into a life of wellness.
