Your presence is important to us – we are not complete without you. We mean it when we say “all are welcome” – no matter where you are on your faith journey or how you identify.

We firmly believe that there is no age limit in GOD's house. Young or old, you are an essential part of our worship community. We encourage families with young children to sit near the front of the sanctuary so children can see what is happening. Parents and other neighboring adults can help developing readers follow along with the congregation and the printed Order of Worship. Be patient with our children as they learn to participate in the rituals of worship.

New Music!

Today our Gathering Hymn is from the new hymnal *All Creation Sings*. The writer of this hymn, liturgical composer David Lohman, creates sacred music to affirm the gifts of LGBTQIA+ people within and beyond the church. “God, we gather as your people” expresses support for LGBTQIA+ children as they discern and grow into their identities. The hymn prays for a safe, affirming church and world to reflect the welcome that God already extends. It also commits the worshipping community to the holy work of hospitality.

Worship & Music Updates

As we continue to adapt to life with COVID-19 – especially the current Delta variant – you will continue to notice adjustments to the way we worship together.

For those not comfortable returning to in-person worship, we will continue to stream our gatherings via Zoom. Please let us know of any suggested improvements.

For those worshipping in-person, we are encouraging all participants to mask at this time regardless of vaccination status due to the Delta variant. This small act helps protect our children and other vulnerable people.

We will continue our current adaptations to our liturgical format including a distanced passing of the peace, individually wrapped communion elements, collecting offering in a stationary basket, and limited singing. We look forward to a time with less risk of infection and a return to sung liturgy, hugs, and full communion tables.
