Worship & Music Updates

For those worshipping in-person, we are encouraging all participants to mask at this time regardless of vaccination statue due to the Delta variant. This small act helps protect our children and other vulnerable people.

We will continue our current adaptations to our liturgical format including a distanced passing of the peace, individually wrapped communion elements, collecting offering in a stationary basket, and limited singing. We look forward to a time with less risk of infection and a return to sung liturgy, hugs, and full communion tables.
